In consideration of payment ___ hereinafter referred to as the "the customer", to Industrial Equipment hereinafter referred to as "the distributor", shall provide the services outlined herein during the service. This preventative maintenance program is designed for your waste water recycling equipment. It provides for our serviceman to inspect and make component tests on your equipment on a regular basis. He will report his findings to you on a report indicating the condition of the equipment and will advise you of any parts or repairs required beyond the terms of this policy.

Machine inspection will be performed _____. A copy of a Preventative Maintenance check list will be provided at the time of each inspection. Industrial Equipment will keep a duplicate file on each piece of equipment. This agreement if accepted is for a period of one year renewable automatically.

This agreement is subject to the following conditions:

- Existing equipment will need an inspection and approval of your machine(s) condition is required before this agreement becomes effective. Regular shop rates will be charged for labor, and parts will be billed at current prices, if required, at the time of inspection.
- Regular preventative maintenance calls will be made _____ as designated above.
- A job site contact or open purchase order is necessary for approval of any additional service parts required i.e. filters, chemicals, or repair parts. _____ (Name/Purchase Order)
- New parts, when required and approved for installation, will be billed at the then current prices.
- Inspection and testing under this agreement is limited to items listed on the attached list, where applicable.
- This agreement may be terminated by either party by giving a 30-day written notice.
- Industrial Equipment shall not be liable for consequential damages of anything, including but not limited to, consequential labor costs or transportation charges in connection with the replacement or repair of defective parts. We make no warranty with respect to trade assessories. They are subject to the warranties of their manufactures. Our obligation is expressly limited to warranty the labor cost for a period of ninety days.
- Industrial Equipment shall not be held responsible for solids waste generated nor does this agreement include cleaning collection pits.
- Oxidizers, chemicals, and filters are available from Industrial Equipment or the customer has the option to provide their own. If, however, the customer does not have their own in stock at the time of service, our service man will add the necessary materials at an additional charge.
- The Service Charge below includes the labor to inspect your equipment on site, perform regularly needed maintenance, and ensure to the best of our ability that your system is functioning properly. Any additional labor or materials needed to repair the system or replace filters/chemical will need approval. These additional charges would then be added to the standard per visit charge.
- The charge per visit also includes the following required materials. If you choose, ___ may provide these materials and the service contract would be renegotiated.
